Diatonic Scales

When starting with a C note and ending with the C note the scale is C Major Scale [Red Notes]

When starting with a A note and ending with the A note the scale is A Minor Scale [Blue Notes]

First Position

The Notes: E F G A B C D E F G A B C D E F G

Start by finding the C note and play to its octave . Then do the same from the A note.

Second Position

Third Position

A B C D E F G A B C D E F G A B C

C D E F G A B C D E F G A B C D

D E F G A B C D E F G A B C D E F
